 2012 FOOD DRIVE BENEFITING ST. MARY’S FOOD BANK ALLIANCE KICKED OFF  
 DURING 12TH ANNUAL AIA FEBRUARY FRENZY**

PHOENIX, AZ (February 2 , 2012) – With 1 in 5 children and 1 in 7 adults living in poverty, hunger is an issue that affects far too many Arizona families. Recognizing the growing need, the Arizona Interscholastic Association (AIA) has announced a community food drive benefiting the St. Mary’s Food Bank Alliance.

During the 2012 AIA February Frenzy Wrestling and Basketball Championship games, fans and players will have an opportunity to help their community by donating canned goods or cash. For each 10 cans of food or \$10 donation, a person will receive a chance to win a 2012/2013 AIA Season Pass or other various prizes. Winners will be announced during the week of February 27, 2012 on aiaonline.org and aia365.com.

To further the effort, the Phoenix Suns will have food collection boxes stationed at the US Airways Center during its matchup against Atlanta Hawks on February 15, 2012.

“We see a real value in developing leadership and philanthropic outreach opportunities for our students. We want to encourage their community participation through this food drive and February Frenzy games are the perfect opportunity for more than 80,000 fans to support these efforts,” said Chuck Schmidt, AIA Associate Executive Director.
